Civil and construction engineer, official of the Ministry of Culture, Head of the Functional Area Technical Office and the Seismic, Safety & Security Offices of the Archaeological Park of Pompeii.

Neapolitan, 54, civil construction engineer, Ph.D. in "Technologies for Building Recovery and Technological Innovation," former contract lecturer at several universities, expert in structural consolidation, former freelancer, author of several notes and publications mainly on the topics of safety, conservation, consolidation and structural restoration.

Since 2015, he has been a member of the Technical Design Secretariat of the Pompeii Archaeological Park for the implementation of works financed by the European Community as part of the Great Pompeii Project. In 2019 he served in support of the Technical Office of the Colosseum Archaeological Park in Rome. Since 2019, he has been an engineer officer of the Ministry of Culture (MIC) at the Archaeological Park of Pompeii, and since 2020 he has also been Head of the functional area Technical Office and in charge as RUP of numerous interventions, designs construction and operational directions and testing on the Administration's interventions related to restoration of Domus (Vettii, Silver Wedding, Diomedes, Faunus, Thermopolium regio V, Insula Occidentalis, Casti Amanti, Insula Meridionalis, Spolettificio di Torre Annunziata, Villa di Poppea in Oplontis, etc.) as well as maintenance, management and restoration of state-owned buildings.

He has been a speaker at numerous national and international conferences and seminars on the topics of restoration, consolidation and management of cultural sites, Member of ArCO (Association for the Recovery of the Built Environment) and ICOMOS Italy. As an ICOMOS Italy member, he was appointed, in November 2024, Coordinator for Italy of the ICAHM Committee on Archaeological Heritage Management, International Scientific Committee on Archaeological Heritage Management.

Since January 2022, he has been coordinating the "Engineering for Cultural Heritage" Commission of the Order of Engineers of the Province of Naples, organizing educational and scientific meetings on the topics of safety, restoration, protection and enhancement of Cultural Heritage.

Currently directing the activities of the Technical Office of the Archaeological Park of Pompeii, he takes care of its triennial planning of OOPPs, and has acted or is acting as Single Project Manager (Project) for more than 100 mln € of interventions financed with ordinary funds of the Park, with CIPRESS funds and/or with PON Culture and Development funds.
